

VILLAGE OF ELMORE

ORDINANCE NO. 19-22

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 951.06 AND 951.09 OF
THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE TO
ELIMINATE REFERENCES TO
THE POSITION OF VILLAGE SUPERINTENDENT**

WHEREAS, the Village has changed to a village administrator form of administration; and,
WHEREAS, the appointment of a village administrator operates to eliminate the position of village superintendent; and,

WHEREAS, Sections 951.06 and 951.09 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Elmore still reference duties of a village superintendent,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. Section 951.06 of the Village Ordinances is hereby amended by changing *village superintendent* to *village administrator* in subsections (g) and (j).

Section 2. Section 951.06 of the Village Ordinances is hereby amended by changing subsection (d) to:

(d) Reservation of Facilities.

Occupy, enter into, loiter, or remain in any pavilion or park structure duly reserved by another person or organization.

Section 3. Section 951.09 of the Village Ordinances is hereby amended by changing subsection (c) to:

(c) Seizure of Property.

Any Village police officer shall have the authority to seize and confiscate any property, thing, or device in a park and used in violation of any of the provision of the provisions of this chapter.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
