ORDINANCE NO. 26-2024

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE FOR WAGE SCHEDULES FOR
EMPLOYEE S OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO and
DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 23-23 passed on November 27, 2023, which amended prior Ordinances respecting job classifications, pay ranges, and compensation; and,

WHEREAS Council would like to provide a 3% change to employees' salaries; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The Ordinance 23-23 passed November 27, 2023, be amended to include the following additional salaries, and.

Section 2. That this attached salary schedule shall be effective for said employees of the Village of Elmore effective January 1, 2025, and continue until a further revision is warranted to be as follows,

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of public health and safety to immediately provide for the salaries and continued employment of essential Village personnel.

Section 4. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code


