AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A FIRST RESPONDER RETENTION INCENTIVE FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Section 5705.09(F), Revised Code, allows for the establishment of a special fund for each class of revenues derived from a source other than the general property tax, which the law requires to be used for a particular purpose: and,

WHEREAS, the Village anticipates the receipt of the Ohio EMA ARPA First Responder Retention Incentive grant, which provides an award for those first responders employed by the Village before June 17, 2022 and who are still employed.

Now THEREFORE be it ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Elmore, Ottawa County, Ohio that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Fiscal Officer is authorized to establish the ARPA First Responder Retention grant fund for the receipt of grant and award payments to the qualified police officers of the Village.

<u>Section 2.</u> That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that any and all deliberations of this Council of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements of the laws of the State of Ohio.
