

**VILLAGE OF ELMORE**

**ORDINANCE NO. 34-21**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORDINANCE 22-21 FOR WAGE SCHEDULES FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OTTAWA COUNTY, OHIO, FOR FISCAL YEAR OF 2022.**

WHEREAS Ordinance No. 26-21 passed on July 26, 2021 which amended prior Ordinances respecting job classifications, pay ranges and compensation needs to be amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Elmore, Ottawa County, Ohio that the pay scale for employees and departments shall be as follows:**

**SECTION 1.** That Ordinance No. 26-21 passed on July 26, 2021, be amended to read as follows, and shall be effective as of January 1, 2022.

**SECTION 2.** That a Salary Schedule for the Year 2022 be as follows.

**Administration**

Mayor	\$9,300 – \$9,700 per year, paid monthly
Council President	\$8,800 – \$9,200 per year, paid monthly
Council Members	\$8,300 – \$8,700 per year, paid monthly

Salaries for the Mayor, Council President, and Council Members shall be paid monthly from the General Fund, Water Fund, Sewer Fund, and Electric Fund.

Village Administrator	\$55,000 – \$74,000 per year, paid bi-weekly
Fiscal Officer	\$20,000 - \$52,000 per year, paid bi-weekly

The Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer salaries shall be paid bi-weekly from the General Fund, Water Fund, Sewer Fund, and Electric Fund.

**Security of Persons, Property, Students, and Pedestrians**

Employees of the Police Department shall be paid in accordance with the following plan:

Police Chief	\$20.00 – \$31.83 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Police Sergeant	\$15.00 – \$26.17 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Full Time Officers	\$15.00 – \$21.61 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Part Time Officer	\$15.00 – \$20.00 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Full Time SRO	TBD by contract with Village of Elmore and Woodmore Schools

Acting Police Chief (40 Hour Minimum)	\$50.00 per week, paid bi-weekly

Police Department wages are to be paid from the General Fund on a bi-weekly basis.

**Department of Public Works**

Working Foreman	\$16.82 – \$29.22 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Serviceman	\$14.43 – \$26.53 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Laborer	\$8.69 – \$21.36 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Utility Clerk	\$9.24 – \$19.25 per hr., paid bi-weekly. Max. 35 hrs.
Custodian	\$10.00 - \$15.00 per hr., paid bi-weekly
Part Time Office Help	\$8.78 – \$11.80 per hr. paid bi-weekly
Acting Superintendent (40 Hour Week)	\$50.00 per week, paid bi-weekly

Wages from the Dept. of public Works shall be paid from the Water Fund, Sewer Fund, Electric Fund, Streets Fund, or from funds applicable to work being completed.

Zoning Administrator \$3,200 - \$3,500 per year, paid monthly  
Zoning Administrator salary shall be paid from the General Fund as applicable on a monthly basis.

**SECTION 3. Council Meeting Attendance**

When any hourly employee is requested by the Mayor, Council, Village Administrator, or Fiscal Officer to attend a Village Council Meeting or Committee Meeting, they will be paid in accordance with the Village of Elmore Employee Handbook.

**SECTION 4 Compensatory Time**

Compensatory time may be given in lieu overtime for non-salaried, non-exempt employees. Compensatory time will be earned at one and one-half of the actual overtime hours worked.
