# AN RESOLUTION DECLARING IT A NECCESSITY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN-MILL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSES SET OUT IN SECTION 5705.19(A) OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE (Current Expenses) AND DECLARING IT AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it was duly moved and seconded for the adoption of the following Resolution;

# NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE, OHIO THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> It is necessary to levy a tax outside the ten-mill limitation to provide for the current expenses; namely for General Fund Operating Expenses, as set out in Section 5705.19(A) of the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C.).

<u>Section 2.</u> Pursuant to Section 5705.03 O.R.C., the Council of the Village of Elmore hereby requests that the Ottawa County Auditor certify to the Village the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by a renewal of a three (3) mill tax levy for said purpose.

<u>Section 3.</u> The term of years of the proposed renewal is five years to first be levied in tax year 2023 and first collected in calendar year 2024.

<u>Section 4.</u> The tax is to be levied upon the entire territory of the Village of Elmore, and the ballot measure proposed herein shall be submitted to the entire territory of the Village of Elmore. The Village of Elmore, Ohio has territory in two counties: Ottawa County and Sandusky County.

<u>Section 5.</u> The question of this tax is proposed to appear on the ballot at the election to be held on November 8, 2022.

<u>Section 6.</u> This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and to keep general funds available so the Village can continue to provide vital services to the community.

<u>Section 7.</u> That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
