RESOLUTION NO. 2-2026

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE VILLAGE OF ELMORE PARKS AND RECREATION MASTER PLAN PREPARED BY MANNIK & SMITH GROUP, INC.

WHEREAS, the Village of Elmore, Ottawa County, Ohio, recognizes the importance of parks, open space, and recreational opportunities to the health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Village desires to provide for the orderly development, improvement, and enhancement of parklands and recreational facilities within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village retained Mannik & Smith Group, Inc. to prepare a comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master Plan evaluating existing park facilities and recommending future improvements and recreational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Mannik & Smith Group, Inc. has completed and submitted a Parks and Recreation Master Plan to the Village for review and consideration; and

WHEREAS, Village Council finds that adoption of the Parks and Recreation Master Plan as a planning and guidance document will assist the Village in making informed decisions regarding park development, improvements, funding opportunities, and recreational programming.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Elmore, Ottawa County, Ohio:

SECTION 1.

The Parks and Recreation Master Plan prepared by **Mannik & Smith Group, Inc.**, a copy of which is on file with the Village Fiscal Officer, is hereby adopted as a planning and guidance

document for the development and improvement of parklands and recreational opportunities within the Village of Elmore.

SECTION 2.


The adopted Master Plan shall serve as a guide for Village officials, boards, and commissions in planning, budgeting, grant applications, and decision-making relating to parks and recreation facilities and programs. Adoption of the Master Plan does not constitute authorization of any specific expenditure or project unless separately approved by Council.

SECTION 3.

The Village Administrator, Mayor, and other appropriate Village officials are authorized to utilize the Master Plan in pursuing funding opportunities, including grants and cooperative agreements, consistent with applicable law and further authorization of Council where required.

SECTION 4.

It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
