

**ORDINANCE NO. 25-09
VILLAGE OF FLANAGAN**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE V, CHAPTER 51,
§51.17 WATER USER CHARGES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES**

(A) Charges. The charge for water service based upon the amount of water consumed as shown by water meters shall be as follows.

(1) ~~The first 1,000 gallons or less of water used per one-month period shall be billed at a rate of \$18.55-\$19.55. A minimum charge of \$19.55 per one-month period to all users whose water consumption does not exceed 1,000 gallons per one-month period. The following billing rate changes will take effect over a three-year period. Changes to the monthly billing will take effect following the month in which this ordinance was passed, for each subsequent year, after a review period by the Board of Trustees of the previous month.~~

Year 1: All water used in excess of the first 1,000 gallons shall be billed at an additional \$6.05 per thousand gallons, or any fraction thereof.

Year 2: All water used in excess of the first 1,000 gallons shall be billed at an additional \$7.90 per thousand gallons, or any fraction thereof.

Year 3: All water used in excess of the first 1,000 gallons shall be billed at an additional \$9.75 per thousand gallons, or any fraction thereof.

(2) ~~A minimum charge of \$10.50 per one-month period shall be charged to all users whose water consumption does not exceed 1,000 gallons per one-month period and for all users who discharge normal strength water to the system. All additional water usage in excess of the initial 1,000 gallons per one-month period shall be billed an additional \$2.95 per thousand gallons, or any fraction thereof. For each user of water services within or outside the Village of Flanagan, the current minimum charge shall be increased by 2% or CPI, whichever is greater, for each subsequent fiscal year starting with the first full billing period after May 1st each year. The CPI rate to be used is the "Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for all items" as published by the United States Department of Labor. In the event that the CPI is greater, the Village Board has the right to increase any percentage below the full CPI, but no less than 2%.~~

(3) A meter service charge will be added per each one-month period to all users in the amount of \$9 to be used for the repair, maintenance, replacement of water meters, and all future infrastructure. For purposes of this division (A), USERS shall be defined as individually-addressed occupancy spaces.

(B) Effective date of rates. The rates and service charges established in this section shall be effective as of ten days following its publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
