AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIQUOR CONTROL ORDINANCE, BY THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it is desired that the City of Greenville Liquor Control Ordinance 2836 be amended in the following respects:

- A. That portion of Section 21-2-6 D, being:

“(D) Class D License (Restaurant)”

A Class D License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor of all varieties on the specified restaurant premises. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue zero (0) type D License. The fee for a Class D License shall be \$600. Class D licenses shall authorize the premises to be open for business from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on each day from Monday through Thursday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day on each Friday and Saturday (Fridays at 6:00 a.m. through Saturday at 1:00 a.m., and Saturdays at 6:00 a.m. through Sunday at 1:00 a.m.), and from 12:00 noon to 12:00 midnight each Sunday. Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.”

is hereby amended and replaced with the new Section 21-2-6 D which will say:

“(D) Class D License (Restaurant)”

A Class D License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor of all varieties on the specified restaurant premises. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue two (2) type D License. The fee for a Class D

License shall be \$600. NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT: That effective February 9, 2016, it is desired that the City of Greenville Liquor Control Ordinance be amended in the following respects:

A. That portion of Section 21-2-6 D, being:

“(D) Class D License (Restaurant)”

A Class D License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor of all varieties on the specified restaurant premises. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue zero (0) type D License. The fee for a Class D License shall be \$600. Class D licenses shall authorize the premises to be open for business from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on each day from Monday through Thursday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day on each Friday and Saturday (Fridays at 6:00 a.m. through Saturday at 1:00 a.m., and Saturdays at 6:00 a.m. through Sunday at 1:00 a.m.), and from 12:00 noon to 12:00 midnight each Sunday. Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.”

is hereby amended and replaced with the new Section 21-2-6 D which will say:

“(D) Class D License (Restaurant)”

A Class D License shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquor of all varieties on the specified restaurant premises. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue two (2) type D License. Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.”

SECTION 2-REPEAL: All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS: In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE: That this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


