ORDINANCE NO. 3147

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GREENVILLE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY  
OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Greenville City Council desires to set forth a rotating schedule for Mayor Pro Tem when the Mayor cannot be present at any city council meetings; and

WHEREAS, ILCS 5/3.1-35-35 sets forth the procedure for a Mayor Pro Tem; temporary chairman;

NOW THEREFORE, let it be ordained:

SECTION1 – GENERAL STATEMENT: The Greenville Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as set forth below:

- a) In the event that the Mayor is unable to be physically present at a regular or special meeting, the meeting will be led by Mayor Pro Tem.
- b) The Mayor Pro Tem shall rotate by quarter based on the years of service of each councilman, if willing to serve.
- c) The councilman with the most years of experience shall serve as Mayor Pro Tem for the fourth quarter, second most years of experience shall serve as Mayor Pro Tem for first quarter, third most years of experience shall serve as Mayor Pro Tem

for second quarter, and fourth most years of experience shall serve as Mayor Pro Tem for third quarter.

- d) Rotation schedule shall continue to be adjusted as the composition of the city council changes, but will follow the schedule set forth above.
- e) In the event that the Mayor is unable to attend, and the scheduled Mayor Pro Tem is unable to attend, the next scheduled Mayor Pro Tem shall conduct the meeting.


**SECTION 2 – EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

**SECTION 3 – REPEAL:** All prior Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 4 – SAVINGS PROVISION:** In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of the Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provision hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.
