AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 118.01: LIQUOR CONTROL GENERAL PROVISIONS; DEFINITIONS OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS

**WHEREAS**, it is desired that the Greenville Code of Ordinances Chapter 118: Liquor Control be amended in the following respects:

A. That portion of Section 118.01, General Provisions; Definitions to add: **SINGLE SERVING**. Individual package alcohol, beer or wine intended for one person. The exception and what is permissible are individual servings of package alcohol, beer or wine that are packaged from the distributor in multiples.

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT:** That effective March 13, 2018, it is desired that Chapter 118, Liquor Control, of City Code be amended in the following respects:

A. That portion of Section 118.01, General Provisions; Definitions to add: **SINGLE SERVING**. Individual package alcohol, beer or wine intended for one person. The exception and what is permissible are individual servings of package alcohol, beer or wine that are packaged from the distributor in multiples.


**SECTION 2-REPEAL:** All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS:** In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE:** That this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
