AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS AND FUNDS OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2018 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2019

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is approparited for all coporate purposes of the City of Greenville, Illinois, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2018 and ending April 30, 2019, the aggregate sum of <u>Forty-Three Million, Six Hundred Eighty-Seven Thousand, Three Hundred Thirty-Five Dollars (\$43,687,335)</u> to be provided for and through the general tax levy of said city for the year 2018 and from other sources of revenue. Section 27. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
