AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 152.41: SIGN REGULATIONS - PROHIBITED SIGNS OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it is desired that the Greenville Code of Ordinances Chapter 152: Sign Regulations; be amended in the following respects:

That portion of Section 152.41, being:

#### 152.41 PROHIBITED SIGNS.

(B) Off-premises signs. Off-premises signs are prohibited. There shall be no display of any signage on any lot or right-of-way, other than the lot on which a sign has direct relation to, except signs which provide directional information to places of worship, less than six square feet.

is hereby amended and replaced with Section 152.41 which shall say:

#### 152.41 PROHIBITED SIGNS.

- (B) Off-premises signs. Off-premises signs are prohibited. There shall be no display of any signage on any lot or right-of-way, other than the lot on which a sign has direct relation to, except;
  - (1) Signs which provide direction information to places of worship, less than six square feet:

- (2) Temporary signs placed in designated right-of-way areas by not-for-profit groups or organization for community events of a fundraising and/or special event nature. Such sign signs shall meet the following conditions:
  - (a) Signs shall be limited to a maximum of 32 sq. ft., or 4'x8';
  - (b) Signs shall be placed only in areas specifically designated by the Code Enforcement Officer;
  - (c) Signs shall be temporary in nature, and shall not be posted for any duration longer than 15 days, including the day of the event;
  - (d) Signs shall be securely anchored, and of such construction to permit a professional appearance for the duration of their posting, and;
  - (e) Signs shall not be for the purpose of advertising the sale of commercial products or services to the general public.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT: That effective upon its passage, it is desired that portion Chapter 152: Sign Regulations; be amended as outlined above.

SECTION 2-REPEAL: All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS: In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE: That this Ordinance shall remain in full force and

effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
