AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 77: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES – STOP
INTERSECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY THE CITY OF
GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, Chapter 77: Traffic Schedules - Schedule VI. Stop Intersections of the Municipal Code of the City of Greenville, identifies stop intersections designated in the City of Greenville; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville City Council has determined that is in the best interest of the public safety of the residents of the City of Greenville to designate a stop intersection at College Avenue and Dewey Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, that Chapter 77: Traffic Schedules - Schedule VI. Stop Intersections of the Municipal Code shall be amended to add the following stop intersection:

SCHEDULE VI. STOP INTERSECTIONS.

It shall be lawful to drive any vehicle into the intersections of the following streets, hereby declared stop streets, without first bringing such vehicles to a full stop at said intersections:

<i>Street</i>	<i>Stop Intersection</i>	<i>Direction</i>
College Avenue	Dewey Street	Eastbound and Westbound

SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT: That effective upon its passage, it is desired that the specific line of Chapter 77, Schedule VI Stop Intersections, be amended as outlined above.


SECTION 2-REPEAL: All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS: In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE: That this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
