AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A REFERENDUM QUESTION TO BE CERTIFIED TO THE MARCH 17, 2020 ILLINOIS GENERAL PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT FOR IMPOSITION OF 1/2% SALES TAX INCREASE FOR PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE IN THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Greenville City Council resolves to place on the March 17, 2020 Illinois General Primary Election Ballot for consideration, the following question; and

WHEREAS, this referendum question is governed by the dictates of 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.1 et seq.;

Shall the City of Greenville impose an increase to the current 1/2% sales tax to a 1% sales tax pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.1 et seq., of the Illinois Municipal Code for Public Infrastructure?	YES

WHEREAS, said revenue is necessary and essential to fund necessary and needed public infrastructure improvements.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE ORDAINED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville as follows:

1. **SECTION - GENERAL STATEMENT:** The above question shall be placed on the March 17, 2020 Illinois General Primary Election Ballot.
2. **SECTION - REPEAL:** All prior ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.
3. **SECTION - SAVINGS PROVISION:** In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.
4. **SECTION - EFFECTIVE DATE:** This ordinance shall become in full force and effect from and upon its passage.
