AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING ALL THE NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2019 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2020

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That for the purpose of defraying all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Greenville for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2019 and ending April 30, 2020, a tax for the following sums, or so much thereof as by law may be authorized, be and the same is hereby levied against all taxable property in the City of Greenville for the following purposes:

- Section 3. That the City Clerk of the City of Greenville be and hereby is authorized and directed to file a copy of this ordinance with the County Clerk of Bond County, Illinois, as provided by law.
- Section 4. If any portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid, such decision shall not effect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and filing, as provided by law.
