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CITY OF GREENVILLE
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ADD CANNABIS REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS OF THE CITY CODE OF
ORDINANCES, BY THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois enacted the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act (Act), which pertains to the possession, use, cultivation, transportation and dispensing of adult-use cannabis, which became effective June 25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Greenville City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public safety of the residents of the City of Greenville to regulate and restrict cannabis in the City of Greenville.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, to amend Chapter 132: Offenses Against Public Order and add Section 132.16, Cannabis Regulations and Restrictions to the Municipal Code as follows:

SECTION 1 The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein.

SECTION 2 Section 132.16 – Cannabis Regulations and Restrictions shall be established by adding the following language:

132.1601 – DEFINITIONS.

ACT. Shall mean the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act of Illinois approved 6-25-19 as Public Act 101-0027.

CANNABIS. Marijuana and other substances that are identified as including any parts of the plant Cannabis sativa and including derivatives or subspecies, such as indica, of all strains of cannabis, whether growing or not; the seeds thereof, the resin extracted from any part of the plant; and any compound,, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the plant, its seeds, or resin, including tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and all other

naturally produced cannabinol derivatives, whether produced directly or indirectly by extraction; however, "cannabis" does not include the mature stalks of the plant, fiber produced from the stalks, oil or cake made from the seeds of the plant, any other compound, manufacture, salt, derivative, mixture, or preparation of the mature stalks (except the resin extracted from it), fiber, oil or cake or the sterilized seed of the plant that is incapable of germination. "Cannabis" does not include industrial hemp as defined and authorized under the Industrial Hemp Act. "Cannabis" also means concentrate and cannabis-infused products.

PERSON. Any person, firm, corporation, association, club, society or other organization, including any owner, manager, proprietor, employee, volunteer or agent.

132.1602 – REGULATIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

- (A) It shall be unlawful to possess or use cannabis on a school bus, on the grounds of a pre-school, primary, or secondary school, unless used by a qualifying patient or caregiver pursuant to the Compassionate Use or Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act;
- (B) It shall be unlawful to possess or use cannabis in a private residence used at any time to provide licensed childcare;
- (C) It shall be unlawful to use cannabis in any motor vehicle, in any public place or in any place where smoking is prohibited under the Smoke Free Illinois Act;
- (D) It shall be unlawful to facilitate the use of cannabis by a person not permitted to use cannabis under the Act;
- (E) It shall be unlawful to knowingly use cannabis in close proximity to anyone under the age of 21 who is not a registered medical cannabis patient under the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act;
- (F) It shall be unlawful for a person to grow cannabis unless authorized by the Compassionate Use of Medical Cannabis Pilot Program Act;

- (G) It shall be unlawful for a person who is 21 years or older and a resident of Illinois to possess more than (i) 30 grams of cannabis flower; (ii) 500 milligrams of THC contained in a cannabis-infused product; or (iii) 5 grams of cannabis concentrate;
- (H) It shall be unlawful for a non-resident of Illinois to possess more than: (i) 15 grams of cannabis flower; (ii) 250 grams of THC contained in a cannabis-infused product; or (iii) 2.5 grams of cannabis concentrate;
- (I) It shall be unlawful for a parent or guardian to knowingly permit the consumption of cannabis by a person under the age of 21 in his or her residence, or any other private property under his or her control, or in any vehicle under his or her control;
- (J) It shall be unlawful for a Dispensary or any other Person or entity to encourage the sale of cannabis or cannabis products by giving away cannabis or cannabis products, by conducting games or competitions related to the consumption of cannabis or cannabis products, or by providing promotional materials or activities of a manner or type that would be appealing to children.

132.1603 VIOLATIONS.

Failure to comply with this Chapter shall be punishable in accordance with §132.99.


SECTION 3-REPEAL: All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS: In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.


