ORDINANCE NO. 3229

AN ORDINANCE MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SEVERAL DEPARTMENTS AND FUNDS OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, ILLINOIS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2020 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2021

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is approparited for all coporate purposes of the City of Greenville, Illinois, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law, for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2020 and ending April 30, 2021, the aggregate sum of <u>Forty-Two Million, Two Hundred Fifty-Two Thousand, Two Hundred Ninety Dollars (\$42,252,290)</u> to be provided for and through the general tax levy of said city for the year 2018 and from other sources of revenue. The objects and purposes for which said aggregate sum is appropriated are as hearinafter set forth.

Section 2. That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of <u>Two Million</u>, <u>Three Hundred Thirty-One Thousand</u>, <u>Three Hundred Ten Dollars (\$2,331,310)</u> for Administration and General Government of said city.
