Ordinance No. 3260

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES,  
CHAPTER 135.05: GAMBLING OFFENSES - EXCEPTIONS  
OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

**WHEREAS**, it is desired that the Greenville Code of Ordinances Section 135.05: Gambling Offenses - Exceptions be amended in the following respects:

That portion of Chapter 135, Gambling Offenses, Section 135.05, Exceptions being:

**Section 135.05: Exceptions**

- A. The gambling prohibitions set forth herein above shall not apply to any game or gambling event for which a license or permit has been issued by the State Gaming board pursuant to the State Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40/1 et seq.; provided that, such game or gaming event is conducted in full and complete compliance with all requirements of said Act and all rules and regulations of the State Gaming Board; and, further provided that, said video gaming occurs within the geographical and signage constraints described in subsections (B) and (C) below.
- B. The geographical constraints are all areas within the boundaries of the city.
- C. Any person or entity which holds a license or permit that has been issued by the State Gaming board for any premises located within a two-city-block radius of the County Courthouse is hereby prohibited from displaying any signage advertising video gaming, which is visible from the exterior of said premises.

is hereby amended and replaced with new Section 135.05, Inspections which shall say:

- A. The gambling prohibitions set forth herein above shall not apply to any game or gambling event for which a license or permit has been issued by the State Gaming board pursuant to the State Video Gaming Act, 230 ILCS 40/1 et seq.; provided that, such game or gaming event is conducted in full and complete compliance with all requirements of said Act and all rules and regulations of the State Gaming Board.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT:** Upon passage, Chapter 135, Gambling Offenses, Section 135.05, Exception shall be amended as outlined above.

**SECTION 2-REPEAL:** All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS:** In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form as provided by law, and shall be full force from its passage.
