AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES,
CHAPTER 34: GENERAL PROVISIONS – RESIDENCY REQUIRED FOR EMPLOYEES
OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, it is desired that the Greenville Code of Ordinances Section 34.007: Inspections be amended in the following respects:

That portion of Chapter 34, General Provisions, Section 34.007, Residency Required for Department Heads:

Section 34.007: Residency Required for Department Heads

Department heads, while encouraged to reside within the city, must reside within a five-mile radius of the city limits. Department heads shall have six months from their date of appointment to meet residency requirements. **DEPARTMENT HEAD** shall mean the Public Works Director, Police Chief, and the City Clerk/Finance Director. Failure to meet residency requirements at any time after the first six months of employment as a department head may result in removal from the position of department head or dismissal.

is hereby amended and replaced with Section 34.007, Residency Requirement for Employees which shall say:

All employees are encouraged to reside within the city limits. In order to timely respond to emergent situations, the City Manager and Chief of Police must reside within a five-mile radius of the city limits. The City Manager and Chief of Police shall have six months from their date of appointment to meet residency requirements. Failure to meet residency requirements at any time after the first six months of employment for the City Manager or Chief of Police may result in removal from the position or dismissal.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT: Upon passage, Chapter 34, General Provisions, Section 34.007, Residency Required for Department Heads shall be amended as outlined above.

SECTION 2-REPEAL: All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.


SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS: In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form as provided by law, and shall be in full force from its passage.
