**ORDINANCE NO. 3274**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LIQOUR CODE REGARDING SPECIAL EVENT LICENSES.**

**WHEREAS**, there are recurring special events that retailers seek licenses such as the Bond County Fair, Art Walk, and Bond County Fourth Fest :

**WHEREAS**, the relevant current code section states:

*Class G license (special event retailer).* A Class G license shall be authorized on a per event basis for the sale of beer or wine for consumption at the location of the special event on the dates prescribed in the application. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue one type G license. If the council chooses to issue a Class G license, the license will be created for the event and cancelled simultaneously with the end of the same event. The fee for a Class G license shall be \$50/event. Class G licenses shall authorize the premises to be open for business from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on each day from Sunday through Thursday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day on each Friday and Saturday (Fridays at 6:00 a.m. through Saturday at 1:00 a.m., and Saturdays at 6:00 a.m. through Sunday at 1:00 a.m.). Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.

**WHEREAS**, the desired new code section states:

*Class G license (special event retailer).* A Class G license shall be authorized for the following events: Bond County Fourth Fest, Bond County Fair, and Art walk. Other special events will be on a per event basis for the sale of beer or wine for consumption at the location of the special event on the dates prescribed in the application. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue one type G license. If the council chooses to issue a Class G license, the license will be created for the event and cancelled simultaneously with the end of the same event. The fee for a Class G license shall be \$50/event. Class G licenses shall authorize the

premises to be open for business from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on each day from Sunday through Thursday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day on each Friday and Saturday (Fridays at 6:00 a.m. through Saturday at 1:00 a.m., and Saturdays at 6:00 a.m. through Sunday at 1:00 a.m.). Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.

**WHEREAS**, the code amendment serves the interest of the efficient administrant of Government and the liquor code.

**NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE ORDAINED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville as follows:

**SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT:** The City of Greenville hereby adopts the amended Section to the liquor code as set forth on the attached **Exhibit A**.

**SECTION 2-REPEAL:** All prior Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are also hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS:** In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.


**SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Ordinance shall become in full force and effect from and upon its passage.
