ORDINANCE NO. 3279

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 78, SCHEDULE I OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, PARKING PROHIBITED, IN THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY ILLINOIS

The City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, in meeting assembled, does hereby find and determine as follows:

WHEREAS, the City Council for the City of Greenville is authorized pursuant to Chapter 78, Schedule I "Parking Prohibited" of the City of Greenville Code of Ordinance and also by Illinois Statute to establish no parking designations within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the public safety of the residents of the City of Greenville to establish a no parking area in the City of Greenville.

NOW THEREFORE, let it be ordained by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville, as follows:

SECTION 1 – GENERAL STATEMENT: That Chapter 78, Schedule I, of the Greenville Code is hereby amended to add the following:

No parking shall be allowed on the either side of Chicago Street east of Trindle to dead end of Chicago.

SECTION 2 – EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

SECTION 3 – REPEAL: All prior Ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4 – SAVINGS PROVISION: In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of the Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provision hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

Adopted this 8th day of August, 2022, at a regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council with a quorum present upon a vote of the City Council as follows:


SECTION 2 – EFFECTIVE DATE: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


