ORDINANCE NO. 3314

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 118: LIQUOR CONTROL OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, BY THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, it is desired that the Greenville Code of Ordinances Chapter 118: Liquor Control be amended in the following respects:

- A. That portion of Section 118.20 G, being:
- (G) Class G license (special event retailer).** A Class G license shall be authorized for the following events: Bond County Fourth Fest, Bond County Fair, and Art Walk. Other special events will be on a per-event basis for the sale of beer or wine for consumption at the location of the special event on the dates prescribed in the application. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue one type G license. If the Council chooses to issue a Class G license, the license will be created for the event and cancelled simultaneously with the end of the same event. The fee for a Class G license shall be \$50/event. Class G licenses shall authorize the premises to be open for business from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on each day from Sunday through Thursday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day on each Friday and Saturday (Fridays at 6:00 a.m. through Saturday at 1:00 a.m., and Saturdays at 6:00 a.m. through Sunday at 1:00 a.m.). Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.

is hereby amended and replaced with the new Section 118.20 G which will say:

(G) Class G license (special event retailer). A Class G license shall be authorized for the following events: Bond County Fourth Fest, Bond County Fair, and Art Walk. Other special events will be on a per-event basis for the sale of beer or wine for consumption at the location of the special event on the dates prescribed in the application. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue seven type G licenses in addition to the three previously mentioned. If the Council chooses to issue a Class G license, the license will be created for the event and cancelled simultaneously with the end of the same event. The fee for a Class G license shall be \$50/event. Class G licenses shall authorize the premises to be open for business from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on each day from Sunday through Thursday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day on each Friday and Saturday (Fridays at 6:00 a.m. through Saturday at 1:00 a.m., and Saturdays at 6:00 a.m. through Sunday at 1:00 a.m.). Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.

NOW, THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Greenville, Bond County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1-GENERAL STATEMENT: That effective October 10, 2023, it is desired that the City of Greenville Liquor Control Ordinance be amended in the following respects:

B. That portion of Section 118.20 G, being:

(G) Class G license (special event retailer). A Class G license shall be authorized for the following events: Bond County Fourth Fest, Bond County Fair, and Art Walk. Other special events will be on a per-event basis for the sale of beer or wine for consumption at the location of the special event on the dates prescribed in the application. The local Liquor Commissioner shall issue one type G license. If the Council chooses to issue a Class G license, the license will be created for the event and cancelled simultaneously with the end of the same event. The fee for a Class G license shall be \$50/event. Class G licenses shall authorize the premises to be open for business from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight on each day from Sunday through Thursday, from 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. the following day on each Friday and Saturday (Fridays at 6:00 a.m. through Saturday at 1:00 a.m., and Saturdays at 6:00 a.m. through Sunday at 1:00 a.m.). Sale of alcohol shall cease promptly at the times set forth above and shall not commence until the approved hours for the following day.

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SECTION 2-REPEAL: All prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


SECTION 3-SAVINGS PROVISIONS: In the event any section, subsection, sentence or phrase of this Ordinance should be declared invalid, all other provisions hereof shall not be affected by such invalidity and shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4-EFFECTIVE DATE: That this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
