ORDINANCE NO. 3319

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF TAXES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING ALL THE NECESSARY EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING MAY 1, 2023 AND ENDING APRIL 30, 2024

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREENVILLE, BOND COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That for the purpose of defraying all the necessary expenses and liabilities of the City of Greenville for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2023 and ending April 30, 2024, a tax for the following sums, or so much thereof as by law may be authorized, be and the same is hereby levied against all taxable property in the City of Greenville for the following purposes:
