## VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS ORDINANCE NUMBER 13-08-01

AMENDMENT OF TITLE 17, CHAPTER 171, SECTION 171.01(E)
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING WATER AND SEWER SERVICE RATES
WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY, ILLINOIS WITH RESPECT TO SWIMMING
POOLS

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City have determined that the methods of dealing with properties with swimming pool credits needs revision; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City have determined that it is necessary and in the best interest of the Village to amend the ordinance regulating water and sewer service rates for the combined wastewater and sewerage system of the Village as hereinafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. Title 17, Chapter 171, Section 171.01(E) of the Hanna City Village Code shall be amended to read as follows:

## Former Language:

Swimming Pool: At the request of a customer, a sewer credit for the amount of gallons of water used to fill a pool will be given 1 time per year per address. Customer must call the Village Water Dept before beginning to fill to request the credit. Any owner of a swimming pool shall be entitled to a sewer credit of a flat rate \$35, if the aforesaid call is made in advance of filling, and the amount of water used that month exceeds the minimum water service rate gallonage threshold. The customer must pay for all water used.

New Language:

Swimming Pool: Any owner of a swimming pool shall be entitled to a sewer credit of a flat rate \$35 one time per year per address, if the customer calls in advance of filling, and the amount of water used that month exceeds the minimum water service rate gallonage threshold. The customer must pay for all water used.

- 3. If any portion of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unenforceable, the remaining portion shall continue in full force and effect.
- 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after ten days following its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
