ORDINANCE NO. 2021- 05-03

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE IX, CHAPTER 90 OF THE HANNA CITY VILLAGE CODE TO REGULATE THE REGISTRATION OF DOGS IN THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, the Village of Hanna City has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Animal Control Act, 510 ILCS 5/1 et seq., the Village of Hanna City has the power to control and regulate dogs and other animals in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board of the Village of Hanna City has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the Village to amend certain provisions of the Village Code relating to the inoculation and registration of dogs within the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein as if fully set forth.

Section 2. Sections 90.04 and 90.05 of the Village Code of the Village of Hanna City shall be combined and amended in their entirety to read as follows:

\S 90.04 DOG INOCULATION AND REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

- (a) No dog shall be permitted to be in or remain in the Village without being inoculated against rabies and registered pursuant to Chapter 5, Article II of the Peoria County Code of Ordinances. Evidence of such inoculation shall be entered upon a certificate, the form of which shall be approved by the County Board, and the certificate shall be signed by the licensed veterinarian administering the vaccine.
- (b) It shall be the duty of the owner of a dog to procure an inoculation tag from the County and cause such inoculation tag to be securely attached to a collar or harness to be worn by the dog whenever the dog is not confined in a secure enclosure. If a dog is not inoculated and registered, said dog shall be impounded and may be redeemed or disposed of as set forth in the impoundment procedures of this Chapter.

The Sections following Section 90.04 shall be renumbered accordingly.

Section 3. Should any portion of this Ordinance be held invalid or illegal, the remaining portions hereof shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, publication and approval as required by law.
