AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE TITLE XI BUSINESS REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 111 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, SECTION 111.10 CLASSIFICATION AND FEES, SUBSECTION (A) CLASS A LICENSE

WHEREAS, the liquor commissioner has recommended an increase in the number of Class A licenses; and

- Section 2. Section 111.10 is hereby amended to change the number of Class A liquor licenses from four (4) to five (5).
