## VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY ORDINANCE NO. 21-*ø*ち -*ゆ*み

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY LIQUOR LICENSING ORDINANCE AND ESTABLISHING A LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATION FOR TEMPORARY LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Village of Hanna City has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq., the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City have the power to determine, by ordinance or resolution, the number, kind and classification of licenses for sale at retail of alcoholic liquor and the amount of the local license fees to be paid for the various kinds of licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hanna City has in place Village Code Section 111.10 establishing the classifications and fees related to local liquor licenses and supplemental licenses within the Village of Hanna City; and

WHEREAS, Village Code Section 111.10 does not currently provide for a temporary liquor license classification within the Village of Hanna City; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hanna City, on occasion, receives inquiries into temporary liquor licenses for events taking place within the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village of Hanna City to amend the liquor licensing code for the purpose of establishing a classification for temporary liquor licenses and identifying the fee amount for the temporary liquor license classification; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY, PEORIA COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein as though fully set forth.
- **Section 2.** Subsection (D) of Section 111.10 of the Village Code of the Village of Hanna City is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:
- (D) Class F license. The local liquor commissioner may, in his discretion, upon proper application being made and upon payment of \$50.00, grant a Class F license for a temporary sale of beer, wine, and pre-mixed beverage to any person lawfully permitted to purchase and consume alcohol for a specific event, not for use as a regularly established business, for use on privately-

owned premises, or publicly-owned premises with written authorization of the public body having charge of such premises, for a certain designated period of time not to exceed seven (7) days. The granting and issuance of a Class F liquor license shall in no way relieve the licensee from any requirements imposed by State law, including but not limited to obtaining a Special Event Retailer's Liquor License (Not-for-Profit) or a Special Use Permit Liquor License from the Illinois Liquor Control Commission.

Section 3. The enumerations of Subsections (D) and (E) of Section 111.10 of the Village Code of the Village of Hanna City shall hereby be changed to Subsections (E) and (F), respectively.

**Section 4.** Should any portion of this Ordinance be held invalid or illegal, the remaining portions hereof shall continue in full force and effect.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately following its passage, publication and approval as required by law.
