ORDINANCE NO. 22- 62 - 61

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PROVISIONS OF TITLE V, PUBLIC WORKS, OF THE VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO METER INSTALLATIONS AND CONNECTION FEES

WHEREAS, the Village of Hanna City has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Hanna City owns and operates a system of waterworks and a sewerage system to provide water and sewer services to the Village's inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-125-3, the corporate authorities of the Village of Hanna City may make all needful rules and regulations concerning the use of water supplied by the waterworks of the Village, and may do all acts and make such rules and regulations for the construction, completion, management, or control of the waterworks; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-141-7, the corporate authorities of the Village of Hanna City may make, enact, and enforce all needful rules and regulations, and ordinances for the improvement, care, and protection of its sewerage system; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-150-1, the corporate authorities of the Village of Hanna City has the power by ordinance to collect a fair and reasonable charge for connection to any system of waterworks or sewerage system operated by the Village; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City that certain provisions of Title V, Public Works, of the Village Code require amending to ensure that water and sewer meters are properly installed, and to ensure that said provisions are consistent with current Village practices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.
- **Section 2.** Section 50.02(A) of the Village of Hanna City Code of Ordinances shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:
  - (A) *Meters required*. Before any premises to be served by Village water are occupied, a water meter shall be installed in a meter pit at the property line thereof by the Village, upon the approval of the Village and payment by the customer of the cost of installing same.

**Section 3.** Section 51.03 of the Village of Hanna City Code of Ordinances shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

## § 51.03 CONNECTION FEES; EXCEPTIONS.

- (A) Applicants for service, either within or outside the corporate limits, in addition to the cost of the approved installation, shall pay non-refundable connection fees in the amount of \$250.00 for water service, and in the amount of \$250.00 for sewer service, for each unit in any building.
- (B) A cash performance bond in the amount of \$200.00 must be deposited with the Water and Sewer Department of the Village prior to the installation of a water service line or sewer service line. This bond shall be returned to the applicant upon the satisfactory completion of the service line hookup and inspection and approval by the duly authorized representative of the Village.

**Section 4.** Section 51.12 of the Village of Hanna City Code of Ordinance shall be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

## § 51.12 INSTALLATION OF ADDITIONAL METERS.

- (A) The Village reserves the right to install meters in existing or future water connections. Where meters are installed, the customer shall be responsible for the cost of the meter and the cost of installation.
- (B) The Village reserves the right to install additional meters, other than the primary meter, in existing or future water connections upon the Village's determination that an additional meter is required. The reasons for which an additional meter may be required include, but are not limited to, faulty existing meters and water loss. Where additional meters are installed, the Village shall be responsible for the cost of the meter and the cost of installation.

**Section 5.** Should any portion of this Ordinance be held invalid or illegal, the remaining portions hereof shall continue in full force and effect.

**Section 6.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
