ORDINANCE NO. 22-10-61

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 111 OF THE VILLAGE OF HANNA CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF CLASS A LIQUOR LICENSES

WHEREAS, the Village of Hanna City has the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Liquor Control Act of 1934, 235 ILCS 5/1-1 et seq., the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City have the power, by general ordinance or resolution, to determine the number, kind and classifications of licenses for the sale of alcoholic liquor at retail within the Village; and

WHEREAS, a restaurant establishment intending to open in the Village of Hanna City has expressed interest in being granted a Class A liquor license; and

WHEREAS, the local liquor commissioner has recommended an increase in the number of Class A liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees have deemed it to be in the best interests of the Village to increase the number of available Class A liquor licenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hanna City, Peoria County, Illinois, as follows:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.
- **Section 2.** Section 111.10(A) of the Village of Hanna City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to change the limit of Class A liquor licenses from six (6) to seven (7).
- **Section 3.** Should any portion of this Ordinance be held invalid or illegal, the remaining portions hereof shall continue in full force and effect.
- **Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
