A resolution providing for and the making of the tax levy for the twelve months beginning May 1, 2023 and ending April 30, 2024 for the uses and purposes herinafter set forth for the Village of Hecker in the State of Illinois after adoption of an appropriation ordinance number 23-\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_\_ adopted on December 12, 2023.
