

**VILLAGE OF HECKER, ILLINOIS**

**ORDINANCE NO.:** 25-12

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1-2-11 OF THE VILLAGE CODE  
REGARDING RULES OF THE VILLAGE BOARD**

**WHEREAS,** the Village of Hecker, Monroe and St. Clair Counties, Illinois (“Village”) is a duly created, organized, and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution (the “Constitution”) and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code (the “Municipal Code”), and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto (Chapter 65, Act 5, Illinois Compiled Statutes (2024)); and

**WHEREAS,** Section 1-2-11 of the Hecker Village Code (“Code”) deals with the Rules of the Village Board; and

**WHEREAS,** the Village now desires to amend Section 1-2-11 of the Code to update the Rules of Order for the Village Board meetings.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hecker, as follows:

1. That the preceding recitations in the upper part of this Ordinance are realleged, restated, and adopted as paragraph one (“1”) of this Ordinance.
2. That Section 1-2-11 (A) of the Village Code shall be hereby amended to read as follows:

**“(A) Order of Business. The order of business shall be as follows:**

- (1) Call to order by presiding officer.
- (2) Roll Call.
- (3) The reading of the journal of the proceedings of the last preceding meeting or meetings, and correction and approval of the same, unless dispensed by the Board of Trustees, and correction of the journals of the proceedings of the previous meetings.
- (4) Reports and Communications from Village Officers.
- (5) Visitors
- (6) Reports of Standing Committees
- (7) Public Works Superintendent
- (8) Zoning Administrator & Board Report
- (9) Attorney’s Report
- (10) Reports of Special Committees

- (11) Presentation of communications, petitions, resolutions, orders, and ordinances by the Board of Trustees.
- (12) Unfinished Business
- (13) Miscellaneous Business"

3. All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

4. That this ordinance shall take full force and effect upon passage and approval as required by law.
