

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPROVAL AND EXECUTION OF A REFUSE
COLLECTION AGREEMENT**

RESOLUTION 25-03

BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Village Board of Trustees of the Village of Hecker, Monroe County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, the Village of Hecker, County of Monroe, State of Illinois (“Village”), is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, Reliable Sanitation Service, Inc. (“Reliable”) is an Illinois business corporation that is engaged in the collection and disposal of garbage, refuse and recyclables; and

WHEREAS, Village and Reliable have agreed to enter into an agreement for the collection and disposal of garbage, refuse and recyclables under the terms set forth in the “Refuse Collection Agreement” attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the terms of the Refuse Collection Agreement include (a) an initial term of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2030, (b) an initial “Base Rate” of \$19.27 per month, (c) an annual increase in amount equal to the percentage of change in the “all items category” of the Consumer Price Index for All Urban customers as published by the bureau of labor statistics of the United States Department of Labor. The monthly charge shall annually be adjusted to reflect the C.P.I or 3%, whichever is greater.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HECKER, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Refuse Collection Agreement in the form attached hereto is hereby approved by the Village of Hecker, Illinois. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Hecker, Illinois.

Section 2. That Aaron Eckart, as Village President, is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver on behalf of the Village of Hecker, Illinois, the Refuse Collection Agreement.

Section 3. Any requirement of competitive bidding for contractual services that may otherwise be applicable is hereby waived by the following vote of two-thirds of the Trustees holding office.

Village Trustee Rich Happel moved the adoption of the above and foregoing Resolution; the motion was seconded by Village Trustee Deanna Louveau; and the vote was as follows:
