



A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE

RELATING TO AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the People of the City and County of Honolulu:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to promote public health, safety, and welfare by enhancing access to automated external defibrillators.

SECTION 2. Article ___ of Chapter 13, Revised Ordinances of Honolulu 1990 ("Public Transit"), as enacted by Section 2 of Ordinance 21-10, is amended to read as follows:

"Article ____ . Automated External Defibrillators

Sec. 13-____.1 Definitions.

"Automated External Defibrillator" means a portable electronic device, approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration, that is capable of diagnosing cardiac arrhythmias and that uses defibrillation to reestablish an effective cardiac rhythm.

~~["Rail car" means any vehicle or rolling stock designed and used for carrying passengers in revenue service on a fixed rail guideway system operated by the city.]~~

~~"Revenue service" means [a rail car that is operating,] the time when a train is available to carry passengers[, and providing public transportation.] and provide transit service. Trains operated in fare-free service are considered in revenue service. Revenue service excludes [non-public transportation activities such as maintenance, testing, or certification.] train testing and maintenance. [Rail cars operated in fare-free service are considered in revenue service.]~~

~~"Train" means four passenger cars coupled together and propelled by self-contained motor equipment to provide transit service on a fixed rail guideway system operated by the city.~~



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Sec. 13-____.2 Requirement to provide automated external defibrillators.

Every [~~rail-car~~] train in revenue service, as defined in this article, must have installed and maintained therein automated external defibrillators in accordance with the requirements of this article. At least [~~one~~] two automated external [~~defibrillator~~] defibrillators that [~~is~~] are accessible to employees and the public, as applicable, must be placed in each [~~rail-car~~] train in revenue service. Appropriate signage must be posted to indicate the location of the automated external defibrillators.

Sec. 13-____.3 Administering agency.

The department of transportation services or another city agency designated by the mayor shall administer [~~the provisions of~~] this article.

Sec. 13-____.4 Notification.

The administering agency shall notify the Honolulu emergency services department, emergency medical services division, of the existence, location, and type of automated external defibrillator installed in each [~~rail-car~~] train.

Sec. 13-____.5 Maintenance.

The administering agency shall conduct periodic inspections of all automated external defibrillators that have been installed in [~~rail-cars~~] trains to ensure that they are maintained in an operative condition, and are replaced or repaired where defective, all according to the operation and maintenance guidelines set forth by the manufacturer."

SECTION 3. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this ordinance for inclusion in the Revised Ordinances of Honolulu, the Revisor of Ordinances need not include the brackets, the material that has been bracketed and stricken, or the underscoring.



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SECTION 4. This ordinance takes effect upon its approval.
