Article 9B

Ordinance Repealing Chapter 2 Article 9
Open Burning Ordinance

Whereas, the Town of Laurel Park originally adopted an “Open Burning Ordinance” as recorded as Chapter 2 Article 9 of the Laurel Park, North Carolina Code of Ordinances on December 16, 2008; and

Whereas, burning in Laurel Park must comply with all air pollution laws, regulations, and ordinances as well as all State and Federal forest fire laws. In order to protect the property of the residents of Laurel Park and to maintain a healthful and pleasant environment; and

Whereas, North Carolina Administrative Code 02D.1903 (1) (B) allows for the open burning of vegetation and undergrowth only if there is “no public pickup services available” within the municipality; and

Whereas, the Town of Laurel Park provides weekly pickup services of bagged leaves through the Laurel Park Public Works Department and larger limb and debris removal at least twice a year and after major storm events; and

Whereas, because North Carolina Administrative Code 02D.1903 (1) (B) invalidates the Town of Laurel Park’s “Open Burning Ordinance Chapter 2 Article 9”, the Laurel Park Town Council must repeal it.


Now Therefore, the Laurel Park Town Council takes the following actions;

- 1) In order to comply with North Carolina Administrative Code 02D.1903 (1) (B) that Chapter 2 Article 9, of the Town of Laurel Park Code of Ordinance, know as “Open Burning Ordinance” is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- 2) This repeal shall be effective June 30, 2019.




