ORDINANCE NO. 25-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MARISSA, ILLINOIS, ENACTING A CODE OF ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF MARISSA, ILLINOIS, REVISING, AMENDING, RESTATING, CODIFYING AND COMPILING CERTAIN EXISTING GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE DEALING WITH SUBJECTS EMBRACED IN SUCH CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Marissa, St. Clair County, Illinois (“Village”), is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held in the Village of Marissa, Illinois at the Marissa Village Hall, 111 N. Main Street, Marissa, Illinois, on June 18, 2025, at 7:00 p.m., before the Village Board of Marissa and notice of said meeting was duly given; and

WHEREAS, the present general and permanent ordinances of the Village are inadequately arranged and classified, are insufficient in form and substance for the complete preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village and for the proper conduct of its affairs, as well as are in need of updating; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/1-1-1, *et seq.*, empowers and authorizes the Village to revise, amend, restate, codify and compile any existing ordinances and all new ordinances not heretofore adopted or published and to incorporate such ordinances into one ordinance in book form; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village has authorized a general compilation, revision, amendment, update, and codification of the ordinances of the Village of a general and permanent nature and publication of such ordinance in book form; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to provide for the usual daily operation and governance of the Village and for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare of the Village that this ordinance take effect at an early date; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to make, revise, amend, restate, codify and compile any existing ordinances and all new ordinances to the Village Code in that form attached hereto and incorporated herein as **Exhibit A**, Revised Code of Ordinances of the Village of Marissa, Illinois’ Table of Contents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MARISSA, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein as findings of the

President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2: The general ordinances of the Village of Marissa, Illinois as revised, amended, restated, codified, and compiled in book form are hereby adopted as and shall constitute the Revised Code of Ordinances of the Village of Marissa, Illinois (a/k/a the “Village Code”).

Section 3: Such Village Code as adopted in Section 2 shall consist of the following Titles: *See* attached **Exhibit A**, incorporated herein by reference, Table of Contents of the Village Code; which shall include those specific parts/sections thereunder.

Section 4: All prior ordinances pertaining to the subjects treated in such Revised Code of Ordinances shall be deemed repealed from and after the effective date of this Ordinance except as they are included and reordained in whole or in part in such Village Code; provided, such repeal shall not affect any offense committed or penalty incurred or any right established prior to the effective date of this Ordinance, nor shall such repeal affect the provisions of ordinances levying taxes, appropriating money, annexing or detaching territory, establishing franchises, or granting special rights to certain persons, authorizing public improvements, authorizing the issuance of bonds or borrowing money, authorizing the purchase or sale of real or personal property, granting or accepting easements, plat or dedication of land to public use, vacating or setting the boundaries of streets or other public places; nor shall such repeal affect any other ordinance of a temporary or special nature or pertaining to subjects not contained in or covered by the Village Code.

Section 5: Such Village Code shall be deemed published as of the day of its adoption and approval by the Legislative Authority, and the Clerk of the Village is hereby authorized and ordered to file a copy of such Village Code in the Office of the Village Clerk.

Section 6: Such Village Code shall be in full force and effect as provided in Section 7, and such Village Code shall be presumptive evidence in all courts and places of the ordinance and all provisions, sections, penalties and regulations therein contained and of the date of passage, and that the same is properly signed, attested, recorded, and approved and that any public hearings and notices thereof as required by law have been given.

Section 7: This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety and general welfare of the people of the Village of Marissa, Illinois, and shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.


