AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MARISSA, ILLINOIS, AMENDING THE VILLAGE'S APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE (#2025-02) BY ESTABLISHING A SALARY/COMPENSATION FOR THE VILLAGE TREASURER AND TRANSFERRING FUNDS TO FUND SUCH SALARY/COMPENSATION

WHEREAS, the Village of Marissa, St. Clair County, Illinois ("Village"), is a duly created, organized and validly existing municipality of the State of Illinois under the 1970 Illinois Constitution and the laws of the State of Illinois, including particularly the Illinois Municipal Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held in the Village of Marissa, Illinois at the Marissa Village Hall, 111 N. Main Street, Marissa, Illinois, on November 17, 2025, at 7:00 p.m., before the Village Board of Marissa and notice of said meeting was duly given; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have opted not to fill the vacant position of City Administrator (§30.162(A)(2)); and

WHEREAS, Title III, Chapter 30, §30.162(C) of the Village Code provides that the Village Administrator is to "perform all functions of the Village Treasurer"; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that for the proper function of the Village governance and to ensure the Village's proper fiscal and financial reporting and compliance, as well as the proper handling of the Village's funds, that they fill the Treasurer position, only, to complete those duties of the Village Treasurer as set forth in the Village's Code; and

WHEREAS, Title III, Chapter 30, §30.009(D) of the Village's Code provides that "The Treasurer shall receive a salary as determined by the annual appropriation ordinance;" and

WHEREAS, previously the Village Administrator position completed the duties and responsibilities of the Village Treasurer, and therefore, no salary/compensation was allocated to the Village Treasurer in Village's Appropriation Ordinance, #2025-02, dated May 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to modify and amend the Village's Appropriation Ordinance, #2025-02, in order to set the Village Treasurer's salary/compensation at \$500.00 per month for the remainder of the current fiscal year (May 1, 2025 – April 30, 2026); and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities desire to further modify and amend the Village's Appropriation Ordinance, #2025-02, by transferring the necessary funds (\$3,000.00) from "General & Administration" account "Village Administrator" for the current fiscal year to the "General Account" and creating a line item thereunder identified as "Treasurer's Salary" in the amount of \$3,000.00, to fund the salary/compensation of the Village Treasurer position for the remainder of the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, establishing the Village Treasurer’s salary/compensation and transferring said funds from the “General & Administrative” account to the “General Account” for the Treasurer’s salary/compensation will neither increase the overall appropriation for the current fiscal year (May 1, 2025 – April 30, 2026) nor deplete entirely a necessary account; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village, its citizens and the public to set the Village’s Treasurer’s salary/compensation for the remainder of the current fiscal year at \$500.00 per month, and modify and amend the current Appropriation Ordinance, #2025-02, to reflect that salary/compensation and fund the Treasurer’s salary/compensation the remainder of the current fiscal year (May 1, 2025 – April 30, 2026) by a transfer of funds between the aforementioned accounts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF MARISSA, ST. CLAIR COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2: That the Village Treasurer’s salary/compensation is hereby set for the remainder of the current fiscal year (May 1, 2025 – April 30, 2026) at \$500.00 per month and the Village’s Appropriation Ordinance, #2025-02, dated May 5, 2025, is hereinafter amended to reflect the same.

Section 3: That the Village’s Appropriation Ordinance, #2025-02, dated May 5, 2025, is hereby modify and amended to reflect the funding of the Village Treasurer’s salary/compensation for the remainder of the current fiscal year (May 1, 2025 – April 30, 2026) by transferring from the “General & Administration” line item of “Village Administrator” \$3,000.00, and establishing a line item under the “General Account” “Governmental Officials” identified as “Treasurer’s Salary” in the same amount--\$3,000.00. All other remaining sections of the Village’s Appropriation Ordinance, #2025-02, shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 4: All other Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, and after publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
