AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 70. STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES. ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL. SEC. 70-14. INJURY TO NEW PAVEMENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Illinois:

Section 1. That Chapter 70. Streets, Sidewalks and other Public Places. Article I. In General. Sec. 70-14. Injury to New Pavements of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Sec. 70-124. Injury to new pavements.

It shall be unlawful to walk upon or drive any vehicle or animal upon or destroy any newly laid sidewalk pavement while such pavement is guarded by a warning sign or barricade, or to knowingly injure_deface any soft, newly laid pavement.

(Code 1976, § 9 ¾-64)

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval as provided by law.
