AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 53. MOBILE HOMES.  
SECTION 53-10. PENALTY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Marshall, Illinois:

Section 1. That Chapter 53. Mobile Homes. Section 53-10. Penalty of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Sec. 53-10. PENALTY.

Any person violates, disobeys, omits, neglects, or refuses to comply with or who resists the enforcement of any of the provisions of this chapter shall be fined ~~not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$500.00 for each offense~~ as allowed in Chapter 1 – General Provisions, section 10 of the Marshall Municipal Code. Each day a violation is permitted to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be published in pamphlet form and shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
