AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 86. UTILITIES. ARTICLE I. IN GENERAL. SEC. 86-26. DISCONNECTION AND RECONNECTION CHARGES OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MARSHALL, ILLINOIS.

Section 1. That Chapter 86. Utilities. Article I. In General. Sec. 86-26. Disconnection and reconnection charges of the Code of Ordinances, City of Marshall, Illinois is hereby amended to read as follows, with strikeouts indicating deletions in text and underscores indicating additions to text:

Section 86-26. Disconnection and reconnection charges.

- (a) For connecting a meter when electrical, gas or water service has been discontinued on account of failure to pay the account at the proper time, a charge of \$25.00 shall be made for reconnecting meter if reconnection is made during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday, and a charge of \$100.00 shall me made for reconnecting the meter at all other times, after settlement of the current as well as delinquent account. No connection charge shall be subject to refund.
- For disconnecting a meter when electrical, gas or water (b) service has been discontinued at the request of the customer, a no charge of \$25.00 shall be made for disconnecting such meter if disconnection is made during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday, and a charge of \$100.00150.00 shall be made for disconnecting the meter at all other times. For reconnecting a meter when electrical, gas or water service has been discontinued at the request of the customer, a charge of \$25.00 shall be made for reconnecting such meter if reconnection is made during the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. on Monday through Friday and a charge of \$100.00150.00 shall be made for reconnecting the meter at all other times. No disconnection or reconnection charge shall be subject to refund.

(c) There shall be no charge to shut off or turn on water at a water meter for an emergency if performed during normal business hours, as long as the emergency situation was not created by the owner or other non-city employees.

Section 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or application thereof, is held invalid by any Court, other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application shall not be affected, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its passage and approval as provided by law.
