## MONROE TOWNSHIP RESOLUTION NO. 2021 -

## RESOLUTION OF MONROE TOWNSHIP, SNYDER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE FEE THAT THE MONROE TOWNSHIP TAX COLLECTOR MAY CHARGE FOR TAX COLLECTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, authorizes the tax collector to charge a percent of the taxes collected as compensation for the work performed by the tax collector; and

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code establishes the maximum percent a tax collector may receive as compensation, based on the population of the municipality;

WHEREAS, based on the most recent population of Monroe Township, the maximum percent a tax collector may receive as compensation from the taxes it collects is five (5) percent.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County, Pennsylvania, does hereby resolve that the Township Tax Collector shall be paid as compensation five (5) percent of the taxes collected.

Enacted as a resolution this 26th day of October, 2021, by the Supervisors of Monroe Township, Snyder County Pennsylvania.
