ORDINANCE NO. 1-2022

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING INSPECTION OF UNDER-SPEED VEHICLES AND ENACTING SECTION 34.22 FOR INCLUSION IN NAVARRE CODIFIED REGULATIONS

Whereas, the Village of Navarre desires to permit the Police Department to inspect "under speed vehicles," commonly referred to as "golf carts," and to ensure that such vehicles are safe to be operated on streets and roads,

Now Therefore, Village Council Ordains as follows, enacting Section 34.22, to be included in its codified municipal regulations:

Section 34.22 – Inspection of under speed vehicles – The Police Department shall perform inspections of under speed vehicles that comply with inspection requirements established by the Ohio Department of Public Safety (DPS-1373), at the Department’s estimated actual cost (currently \$40), and is authorized to perform inspections of similar vehicles for non-Village residents for \$75 per inspection. For the purpose of this Section, "under speed vehicle" means a three or four wheeled vehicle, including a vehicle commonly known as a golf cart with an attainable speed on a paved level surface of not more than twenty (20) miles per hour and with a gross vehicle weight rating less than three thousand (3,000) pounds as set forth in Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 4501.01(XX).

At the time of inspection, the owner/operator of the under speed vehicle must present the following the Navarre Police Department – (i) valid driver’s license, (ii) proof of insurance relating to use of the under speed vehicle, (iii) proof of registration, and (iv) gross vehicle weight. The Navarre Police Department shall have the right to not issue an inspection certificate to any applicant for any or no reason.

Inspection fees, though to be paid to the Clerk-Treasurer, shall be for the benefit of the Police Department, and the amounts so collected shall be added to the appropriation for the Police Department, for uses deemed necessary by the Police Chief, with approval of the Mayor.
