ORDINANCE NO. 1-2024

AN ORDINANCE AWARDDING CONTRACT FOR VILLAGE OF NAVARRE 2024
PUBLIC STREET PAVING PROJECT, INCLUDING TUSCARAWAS STREET
ALTERNATE, TO BARBICAS CONSTRUCTION CO.

Whereas the Village of Navarre, Ohio publicly advertised for sealed bids for a certain construction project, "Village of Navarre, Ohio 2024 Public Street Paving" (the Project), in accordance with applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, and

Whereas, on November 30, 2023, sealed bids were opened, and the low bidder for the base project, with the Tuscarawas Street alternate, was Barbicas Construction Co, in the sum of \$268,392.60, part of which is lump sum and part of which is unit prices, and

Whereas, the Barbicas Construction bid was below the Engineer's estimate, and the Engineer has determined that, under all of the circumstances, the Barbicas Construction bid is the "best bid," as provided for in the Instructions to Bidders, and

Whereas, the Barbicas Construction bid qualifies under either applicable legal standard, those being "lowest and best," and "lowest responsible bidder," and

Whereas, time is of the essence, as the Project needs to be awarded before Spring, 2024 construction schedules are set, which could impact the timely completion of the Project,

Now Therefore, The Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains and Authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into a contract with Barbicas Construction Co., in a form acceptable to the Village Solicitor, in the amount of \$268,392.60.

Wherefore, this ordinance will take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance, being reasonably necessary for the fiscal wellbeing of the Village, particularly inasmuch as the Village desires that this Project be awarded and a contract signed as quickly as possible so as to advance the Project on the 2024 calendar, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three-reading rule and adopt this measure as an Emergency.
