ORDINANCE NO. 10-2023

AN ORDINANCE STATING WHAT SERVICES THE  
VILLAGE WILL PROVIDE TO BLOUGH AVENUE ANNEXATION  
TERRITORY UPON ANNEXATION

Whereas, Kirby Brothers, LLC owns 6500 Blough Avenue located within Bethlehem Township, also known as Stark County Auditor tax parcel numbers 1001611, 1000479, and 1003803, containing 35.45 acres, more or less, and being adjacent to the southern boundary of the Village, and

Whereas, Kirby Brothers, LLC desires to hook into the Village's wastewater treatment system and further desires Village police protection, and

Whereas, in order to hook into the Village's wastewater treatment system and to procure police protection, Kirby Brothers, LLC has submitted a petition for annexation of the foregoing parcels into the Village of Navarre, for an Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 709.022 annexation, which petition will be submitted to the Board of Commissioners of Stark County,

*Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains as follows:*

That upon annexation, the Village shall provide police department protection to the annexation territory, and will permit the annexation territory owner to hook into the Village wastewater treatment system, after the owner procures all necessary approvals from Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and applicable Stark County agencies.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approved by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance, being reasonably necessary for the health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Navarre, particularly as it permits the expansion of the Village's wastewater treatment system south of the Tuscarawas River, and to pose no delay in the annexation process, and should therefore be passed as an EMERGENCY, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three readings rule and adopt this measure as an EMERGENCY.
