ORDINANCE NO. 11-2023

AN ORDINANCE STATING WHAT SERVICES THE
VILLAGE WILL PROVIDE HUDSON DRIVE ANNEXATION
TERRITORY UPON ANNEXATION

Whereas, the Village of Navarre owns two undeveloped parcels, on Hudson Drive SW and Riverland Avenue SW located within Bethlehem Township, also known as Stark County Auditor tax parcel numbers 1080050 and 1080051, containing 18.75 acres, more or less, and being adjacent to the southern boundary of the Village, and

Whereas, the Village of Navarre is filing two petitions for annexations of the foregoing parcels, under Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 709.16, one of the petitions being for 14.52 acres, more or less, and the other petition being for 4.23 acres more or less,

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains as follows:

That upon annexation, the Village shall provide police department protection to the annexation territory, and all other services that are customary within municipal boundaries.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approved by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance, being reasonably necessary for the health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Navarre, particularly as it permits the bringing into the Village of its wastewater treatment system as the Village begins the process of designing an expansion and reconstruction of same, and should therefore be passed as an EMERGENCY, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three readings rule and adopt this measure as an EMERGENCY.
