ORDINANCE NO. 12-2023

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING NEW MUNICIPAL REGULATION
90.28, REGULATING CATS AND OTHER DOMESTIC ANIMALS
AT LARGE, OTHER THAN DOGS

Whereas, Village Council is concerned over a proliferation of cats, both domestic and feral, and other domestic animals, other than those enumerated in Section 90.01, running at large in the Village's residential zones and otherwise constituting a nuisance to the residents thereof,

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains and enacts new Village of Navarre Municipal Regulation 90.28, which will provide as follows:

Section 90.28 – Cats and Other Domestic Animal at Large, Other than Dogs.

- (A) No person, being the owner of or having charge of any cat or other domestic animal, other than a dog, whether wearing a registration tag or microchip or not, shall permit such other domestic animal to run at large upon any public place or on the premises of another.
- (B) Any cat or other domestic animal, other than a dog, found running at large or on the premises of another, that is not identified by a registration tag or microchip shall be presumed to be feral, and may be trapped by any person, whether or not employed by the Village, and delivered to a cat or other domestic animal shelter within Stark County, Ohio, or in an adjacent county in the event the Stark County shelter is closed or not taking cats at the time.
- (C) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor. A second violation within one year is a fourth degree misdemeanor.
