ORDINANCE NO. 13-2023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 76.99 OF THE NAVARRE MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS, WITH RESPECT TO PARKING OFFENSE PENALTIES

Whereas, parking violations have proliferated in the business portions of the Village, and the cost of enforcement has dramatically increased, Village Council deems it appropriate to increase fines for parking violations, and amends Section 76.99 of the Village's codified Municipal Regulations, as set forth hereinafter. All other provisions in Chapter 76 of the Village's codified Municipal Regulations remain in place and effect.

Section 76.99 - PENALTIES

(A) *The Police Department shall ticket all violations of Chapter 76 of these Municipal Regulations. All tickets for a violation of any portion of this chapter 76 shall result in a \$50 fine per violation. If a parking ticket is not paid within ten (10) days of being issued, the fine shall be \$75.*

(B) *Any vehicle that is subject to three or more unpaid parking tickets may be towed by or at the direction of the Police Department, either to the Police Department parking lot or to a commercial tow yard within ten (10) miles of Navarre, and said vehicle shall not be released to its owner until the owner pays the unpaid tickets, the tow bill and any associated costs. The Village of Navarre and its employees are not liable for any damages to a vehicle that is towed pursuant to this Section.*
