VILLAGE OF NAVARRE STARK COUNTY, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 15-2023

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ANNEXATION OF BLOUGH AVE. SW ANNEXATION TERRITORY (PARCELS 1001611, 1000479, AND 1003803)

Whereas, on or about August 12, 2023, the owner/applicant of Stark County tax parcels 1001611, 1000479, and 1003803, all lying on Blough Ave. SW, submitted a petition to annex said parcels into the Village of Navarre, and

Whereas, the Board of Stark County Commissioners, on September 13, 2023, entered onto its journal an order granting said petition,

Now Therefore, Village Council Ordains as follows:

- (1) That the annexation of the aforesaid territory is accepted, and
- (2) The Fiscal Officer and other Village officials are directed to take all action necessary under the Ohio Revised Code, to complete said annexation, including but not limited to, giving the annexation territory a Village lot number, recording the mylar (map) and this ordinance with the Stark County Recorder after first presenting them to the Stark County Auditor, and all other actions deemed necessary for said annexation to be completed.

Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance, being reasonably necessary for the health, welfare, and safety of the Village of Navarre, particularly as it relates to ensuring that the Village of Navarre police department can promptly begin offering protective services within the annexation territory, and so that the applicant can begin constructing the private sewer system, and should therefore be passed as an EMERGENCY, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three readings rule and adopt this measure as an EMERGENCY.
