VILLAGE OF NAVARRE STARK COUNTY, OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 19-2022

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING NEW SECTION 10.20 OF THE VILLAGE OF NAVARRE CODIFIED MUNICIPAL REGULATIONS, REGARDING REPEAT VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCES THAT REQUIRE NOTICE OF VIOLATION BEFORE PROSECUTION OR VILLAGE "SELF-HELP" ACTION

Whereas, the Codified Municipal Regulations of the Village of Navarre presently contain, or in the future, may contain numerous provisions where, before the Village may take an official action against a person or property, a notice of violation of a prohibition must be delivered to the person, either in person or by certified mail, return receipt requested, and

Whereas, a recurring problem is that persons to whom such notices are provided comply temporarily with the requested action set forth in such notices, following which they repeat the same or substantially similar violations, thus triggering a need under Village Codified Municipal Regulations to deliver the same written notice again, and thus indirectly allowing the same or substantially similar violations to occur unabated during the notice period, and

Whereas, all of the foregoing typically subjects neighbors and other persons living in and visiting the Village to a substantial nuisance and annoyance, which conduct and delay frustrates the Village's ability to enforce its regulations and ordinances which are for the protection of the Village's residents, landowners, and visitors, and

Whereas, Council desires to limit the nuisance and annoyance that continued repeat violations of its regulations and ordinances,

Now Therefore, the Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains as follows, by enacting new Sections 10.20, in its General Provisions, which shall read:

<u>Section 10.20 – Repeat violations of ordinances requiring written notice</u> <u>prior to official action.</u>

- (A) <u>Application</u>. This section applies to any other section of these Municipal Regulations that requires that the Village serve a written notice of violation before taking further action against the intended recipient of the notice of violation.
- (B) Repeat violation after perfection of service of written notice. Where service of a required written notice is perfected and is followed by a period of apparent compliance with the applicable municipal regulation, and the notice recipient re-engages in the same or substantially similar conduct in violation of said municipal regulation, then the Village may serve the notice percipient with an ordinary mail dated notice of violation and demand to abate the violation within ten days. Notice shall be deemed to have been completed hereunder on the fourth business day after such notice is mailed from a United States post office box.
