ORDINANCE NO. 23-2022

AN ORDINANCE AWARING CONTRACT FOR RECONSTRUCTION OF EAST CANAL STREET BETWEEN MAIN STREET AND MARKET STREET AND 2023 PUBLIC STREET PAVING PROJECT TO NORTHSTAR ASPHALT, INC.

Whereas the Village of Navarre, Ohio publicly advertised for sealed bids for a certain construction project, "Reconstruction of East Canal Street between Main Street and Market Street and 2023 Public Street Paving" (the Project), in accordance with applicable provisions of the Ohio Revised Code, and

Whereas, on November 17, 2022, sealed bids were opened, and the low bidder was Northstar Asphalt, Inc. ("Northstar"), overall and on each sub-part of the whole (Items 1-24, Items 25-27, Items 28-32, Items 33-38, Items 39-41, Items 42-45, and Items 46-48, and

Whereas, the Northstar bid(s) was/were below the Engineer's estimate, and the Engineer has determined that, under all of the circumstances, the Northstar bid is the "best bid," as provided for in Section 10 of the Information to Bidders; and has further determined that Northstar has the requisite experience for the project under Section 13 of the Information to Bidders, and

Whereas, the Northstar bid qualifies under either applicable legal standard, those being "lowest and best," and "lowest responsible bidder," and

Whereas, Council has considered the funds available for the Project, and has determined that an award should be made, and a contract entered into, for Bid Items 1-24, for which Northstar's bid was \$494,470, Bid Items 25-27, for which Northstar's bid was \$64,930, and Bid Items 33-38, for which Northstar's bid was \$98,720, said contract to be part fixed sum and part unit price, and

Whereas, time is of the essence, as an award of the project and contract must occur within the time specified in the Information to Bidders,

*Now Therefore, The Village Council of Navarre, Ohio Ordains and Authorizes the Village Administrator to enter into a contract with Northstar Asphalt, Inc., in a form acceptable to the Village Solicitor, in the following amounts - \$494,470 for Bid Items 1-24, \$64,930 for Bid Items 25-27, and \$98,720 for Bid Items 33-38, total - \$658,120.*

Wherefore, this ordinance will take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor. Further, Council declares that this ordinance, being reasonably necessary for the fiscal wellbeing of the Village, particularly inasmuch as the Village desires that this Project be awarded as soon as possible to lock in the bid and prices contained therein, with the number of votes necessary to waive the three reading rule and adopt this measure as an Emergency.
