ORDINANCE NO. 3-2023

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING FISCAL OFFICER'S  
RESIDENCE OUTSIDE VILLAGE PURSUANT TO  
OHIO REVISED CODE, SEC. 733.262(D)

Whereas, the Village of Navarre hired Kim Meek-Obed as its new fiscal officer, effective February 27, 2023, and

Whereas, Kim Meek-Obed is not currently a resident of the Village and has advised that she desires to continue to reside in her long time residence in Tuscarawas County, and

Whereas, Ohio Revised Code, Sec. 733.262(D) provides that a new village fiscal officer need not be a village resident at the time of hiring, but must become a resident of the village within six months of hiring, unless the village council passes an ordinance approving the fiscal officer's residence outside of the village, and

Whereas, Village Council is of the opinion that Kim Meek-Obed can adequately perform the duties of fiscal officer without being a Village resident,

Now Therefore, Village Council *Ordains* that: *Kim Meek-Obed shall not be required to become a Village resident under Sec. 733.262(D); however, this waiver of residence applies only to Kim Meek-Obed, and not to future Village fiscal officers.*
